OBLIGATION TO REPORT CHANGES

You are obligated to report **all changes** to your application on a continuing basis. Your application must correctly and fully disclose all information up to the time you take the Oath of Admission as a Colorado attorney. In the event any change occurs after the original filing of your application, you are required, within 30 days of such change or occurrence or prior to taking the Oath of Admission, whichever occurs first, file an amendment to your application setting forth complete information regarding any matter called for by the application.

This includes changes of **address, employment, or any circumstance** that might reflect negatively on your ethical and moral qualifications for admission. Failure to report changes to your application may result in the denial of your application for admission to practice law in Colorado.

All changes must be submitted **in writing** and will not be accepted over the telephone. Changes may be reported using the Amendment Form included with your application or in letter form. Submissions must be signed and dated, reference the applicable question number and your application number.
