People v. Smith, No. 00PDJ081 (consolidated with 00PDJ071). 12.19.01 Attorney Regulation. The Presiding Disciplinary Judge approved the parties' Conditional Admission of Misconduct and suspended the Respondent, James D. "Kimo" Smith, for a period of one year and one day with all but sixty days of the suspension stayed during a two-year period of probation subject to conditions. Respondent was convicted of criminal mischief involving damage to a vehicle, and admitted his conduct constituted grounds for discipline pursuant to C.R.C.P. 251.5(b) and a violation of Colo. RPC 8.4(b). Respondent was ordered to pay the costs of the disciplinary proceeding.
